




## Notes – Important information – Please read thoroughly:

Autumn Clubs will run for 11 weeks (unless otherwise stated) from week beginning 13<sup>th</sup> September to 29<sup>th</sup> November (excluding half term w/c 25<sup>th</sup> October).

### Enrolments

- If you wish to enrol in a club for the Autumn term, please complete an enrolment form (1 per child) and provide the relevant payments as indicated on the enrolment form. Please use one enrolment form per child, per term, additional forms can be obtained from the school foyer.
- Please write your child(ren's) name(s) on the back of any cheques, together with their year group and class teacher. **Cheques should be made payable to the Tutor running the club.** If you are enrolling your child/ren into several different clubs please make one cheque payable for one club and/or one child.
- In order to secure your place, enrolment forms **MUST** be accompanied by payment. Cheques will **NOT** be banked until the clubs start in September, all payments are essential to reserve your place. If you have any problems paying for a club please speak to me on a confidential basis to discuss a possible solution.
- You will receive confirmation of your child's place on any club during the week beginning 6<sup>th</sup> September. Please provide an e-mail address if possible as this is the most reliable means of communication.

**BALLET/MODERN/JAZZ** – With Modern Dance, along side the exam syllabus students will learn different dance routines to a range of music and a wide variety of dance styles including: Disco, pop, contemporary, lyrical, Jazz & hip hop. Please note: exams are not compulsory and students are more than welcome to participate for fun and fitness.

**SCIENCE CLUB** – Back by popular demand this great club has returned for one term only. This term their 6 topics will be Watts-Up; Optical Illusions; Light..Colour..Action!; Slime!; Sonic Sounds and Harnessing Heat.

**FRENCH FOR FUN** – Children will learn French through the use of games and a fun workbook and interactive CD to take home (a yearly charge of £16 applies for the book and CD).

**PHILOSOPHY CLUB** – is a chance for young people to discuss at length and at leisure things which interest them. This is essentially a talking shop which focuses on interesting questions and puzzles which are thrown up by a stimulus such as a newspaper article, a story, a painting, a film, in fact just about anything which can lead to a fruitful discussion. All points of view are welcome and all are valued. We have a juice and biscuit break during each meeting and carry over the most interesting discussions into the next meeting. Children will be encouraged to contribute to an online forum on the current topic and later in the term interested parents will be invited to join a meeting and take part!

**GYMNASTICS** – This club has a new tutor this term as Charlotte has finished her University Degree in Cambridge and has moved on to pastures new. Stephanie comes with good recommendations and is fully qualified.

**FUNK IT UP DANCE** – a fun club for both boys and girls to learn dance styles such as Street Jazz, Breakdancing, Hip Hop etc. Sarah will teach you to dance like the commercial dance videos of your favourite artists!

**GUITAR LESSONS** – These lessons run slightly differently to all the other clubs in that they continue from term to term with the same children so that there is some continuity for the child. Places will become available when a child either leaves the school or decides not to carry on with the lessons. There is currently a waiting list and if you would like your child's name added please contact me.

**DIGITAL ART** – is about taking good photographs and creating art using cameras, scanners as well as using software like Photoshop and Paint Shop Pro. Children will be able to work on projects that interest them and over the year will not only have an opportunity to build up their photographic skills but also learn how to optimise their pictures and also use image editing software to work with drawings and other art work.

**CREATIVE MUSIC MAKING CLUB** – Come and form a band! No previous experience needed but if you do play a portable instrument then bring it along – we will work together to form a band, write our own music and maybe even make a CD and give a concert! There will be lots of instruments to try including djembes, log drums and frog guiro!
